At the Aug 27th selectmen's meeting we all agreed to the amended version of the Quarry Policy below:

DRAFT POLICY REGARDING AUTHORIZED USES OF PROPERTY LOCATED AT MASON QUARRY

The property is open to the use of Mason residents only. An exception is made for non-residents who are the guests of a Mason resident. The guests must be accompanied by the resident at all times while using the property.

Users of the property are subject to all applicable laws, regulations, and Town Ordinances.

No alcohol is permitted on the property.

Parking is to be in the **designated** authorized areas only.

(These areas, located near the end of the Class 5 section of Scripps Lane, will be determined in consultation with Police and Highway Dept. heads)

Use of the property is limited to the hours between dawn and dusk unless prior approval is obtained in writing from the Conservation Commission (and Office of the Selectmen).

No fires are authorized without a **burn permit from the Fire Department**.

There is no lifeguard on duty. Any swimming is done at the sole risk of the swimmer.

No diving **or jumping** is allowed.

All trash and/debris is to be removed from the property by the user.
