# Article 03 To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate

To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of One Million, Eight Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand, Eight Hundred Eighty Three Dollars (\$1,854,883.00) for general municipal operations. This article does not include appropriations contained in special or individual articles addressed separately. (Majority vote required)

#### Article 04 Police Cruiser Reserve Fund

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Fourteen Thousand Dollars (\$14,000) to be added to the Police Cruiser Capital Reserve Fund previously established. (Majority vote required.) Recommended by the Selectmen.

#### Article 05 Paved Road Maintenance

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$65,000) for the purpose of repair and maintenance of the Town's paved roads, or take any other action relative thereto. (majority vote required.) Recommended by the Selectmen.

# Article 06 Fire Department Vehicle Capital Reserve Fund

To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) to be added to the Fire Department Vehicle Capital Reserve Fund previously established. (Majority vote required.) Recommended by the Selectmen.
