

# FIRE PERMITS REQUIRED BY LAW

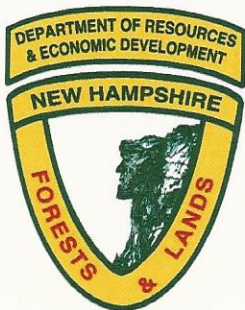
In New Hampshire RSA 227-L:17 requires that: a fire permit be obtained by the person conducting and responsible for the open burning whenever the ground is not covered with snow within a 100 foot radius of the burn site. Please be advised that some communities may also have additional restrictions regarding open burning and specific local permitting requirements.

- Contact your local Forest Fire Warden, Deputy Warden or a fire department official to obtain a written fire permit.
